SWS AAPG Scholarships:

- Confirmed five scholarships were awarded by the SWS last year, each candidate received \$1,500
- Need to update the SWS website to reflect the IBA and scholarship awards
- Eric will reach out to several schools soon about the scholarship program

SWS 2019 Bill Hailey Short Course Status:

- Venues: Currently working on venues for both Abilene and Fort Worth. Abilene availability and options more limited, so Jeff is checking several possible venues. Only January 24th available at UTA for the DFW course with the same large 280 person room as last year. Smaller room with 240 person limit has more days available. Officers noted they would prefer the larger room to accommodate more participants. If needed, several days available at TCU and Cowboy stadium at a significantly higher cost.
- Currently the only speaker identified is John Lorenz focused on Fractured Reservoirs. He is interested and available in January 2019. Will need to modify his class to fit into one day.

SWS 2019 Dallas Convention Status:

- Arrangements for the convention are coming along nicely
- Theme: Exploration Centennial: Onward to the Next Century, Dallas 100th Year Anniversary of DGS
- Location: Irving Convention Center (ICC), Contracted for April 7-9, 2019, (Sunday-Tuesday) for exhibit hall, icebreaker, technical sessions, and luncheons. The field trip on April 6 (Saturday) will not use the ICC.
- Hotels: Full service Westin Hotel across the street from the ICC has been contracted as the headquarters hotel. Blocked 60 rooms at a convention rate of \$159/night. The nearby Holiday Inn Express also has a block of 40 rooms at \$109/night, but it will require a short shuttle ride to the ICC. Texican will also be available.
- Website: Calvin created a dedicated convention website that is live now. Will be updated as they progress. Go to https://www.2019aapgswsconvention.org/
- Field Trip: Bo organizing a one-day field trip for Saturday, April 6. Woodbine and dinosaur tracks, Lake Grapevine.
- First 200 members who sign up for the short course attend for free according to By-Laws; attendees pay for food.
- Short Course: Ron is finalizing the short course to be held at the ICC on Sunday, April 7. Likely carbonates focused.
- Technical Program: Joe and Trey are compiling a list of potential speakers and making initial contacts. Pioneer is planning to sponsor a half-day series of talks. An email initial call for papers will be broadcast to the SWS.
- Social Program: The icebreaker will be in the ICC exhibit hall Sunday evening.
- Sponsorships: Pioneer Natural Resources has committed to be the lead Diamond sponsor for the convention, and a few select other companies have been contacted. Tina will start a more aggressive sponsor recruitment in fall.
- Exhibitors: Steve has contacted a broad group of companies to exhibit at the convention and has several commitments in hand. Need a W9 form from the SWS to be able to exhibit.
- More! Rocks in Your Head: Paul is working with Richard Opalka to put together this course for area earth science teachers, to be held Saturday, April 6th. Currently seeking financial support. Applied to WTGS for \$3,000 support. Karin recommended submitting a proposal to the AAPG Foundation as an ongoing program. Bob will follow-up on the AAPG website to go through the process.
- Other details pertaining to site set-up, judges and moderators, student expo, signage, on-site registration, meals, etc., will be handled closer to the convention. Planning another meeting or conference call in September.
- Poster slots will be unlimited. Targeting 38-40 technical talks.

SWS AAPG Election By-Laws Change:

- Three 2018 officer positions ran unopposed. Hard to find people to volunteer. Declining membership is an issue in RGS. Many local GS's are having issues with finding people to run for Officer positions.
- Agreed to wait on Nic's recruitment response before modifying By-Laws.
- Nic is working on candidates for next year's election and is targeting to have the ballot ready by March 1, 2019.
- Joe Davis: Nominations for national AAPG Officer Elections are due August 15th. Award nominations soon after.

Upcoming Meetings:

- Next meeting August 20th at Noon (teleconference)
- Will have face-to-face SWS BOD meetings at the WTGS Symposium in Midland on Wednesday, September 26th at noon. Will send out more details soon on this meeting.
- Recommend to plan flights and hotels now because Midland is booming again!
